



Safe Firearm Storage Pilot Program Run of Show

WHAT: Cleveland Public Library, in partnership with State Rep. Darnell Brewer, the Cuyahoga County Office of Violence Prevention, and The Academy of Medicine of Cleveland and Northern Ohio (AMCNO) will announce a year-long pilot program providing free gun safes and gun locks to Cleveland residents. The initiative promotes responsible firearm storage and community safety by helping prevent accidental injuries, theft, and misuse.

Gun safes and locks will be available while supplies last at the Lorain, Rice, and Glenville campuses. The pilot will also include programming and education focused on violence prevention and responsible storage.

Firearms are not permitted in Library facilities, and residents should not bring firearms when picking up a gun lock or safe.
